The REME Ready! volunteers will enhance a visit to the Museum through the stories and memories of veterans and currently serving personnel.

We are looking for reliable people who are friendly, approachable and engaging, and who are enthusiastic about meeting new people and sharing their experiences of serving with the Corps. You do not need to give speeches or lead tours, as you will be talking with visitors about your own memories and stories, or drawing on your knowledge of the Corps.

You will be keen to share your service with the public, and help people understand REME's special purpose, skills and *esprit de corps*.

This is a great way for you to support your Museum and make sure visitors enjoy their day out. It is also an excellent opportunity to meet other serving and retired members of the Corps. Full training and a note pack will be provided. We are also able to provide travel expenses of 30p per mile up to a maximum value of £25.

We feel that two of the Museum's spaces particularly lend themselves to this form of interpretation, namely the World War Two display and the REME Ready Gallery. There you will do the following.

- Greet visitors to the Galleries.
- Talk about your own experience of life in the Corps, particularly relating to the objects and vehicles on display, or discuss REME's vital contribution to the Second World War.
- Answer questions from visitors and provide directions.

The Museum is open from Tuesday to Sunday inclusively, so we are looking for a number of volunteers to be on hand during the week. We will work with you to ensure your time commitment is mutually convenient.
